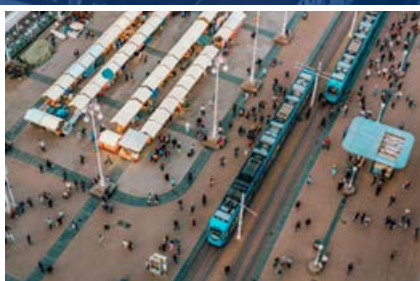

Important Travel Information for Foreign Visitors to Croatia:

As of January 1, 2023, the Republic of Croatia has become a full member of the Schengen Area, allowing smooth travel within its borders. However, please note that certain third-country nationals may still require a visa for entry. The travel document used to enter Croatia must be valid for at least three months beyond the planned departure date and issued within the last 10 years (e.g., a third-country national staying in Croatia until December 26, 2013, must hold a passport valid until at least March 27, 2014). This visa requirement does not apply to EU/EEA citizens, who can enter Croatia with a passport or identity card valid for the duration of their stay.
